The Crystal Lake School PTO is a group of parent volunteers working together to support our students, teachers and staff so that our children have the best educational experience possible. This Handbook provides information about fundraisers and events that the PTO runs during the school year. You will also find information on how to get involved and various ways to support our PTO.

WAYS TO SUPPORT OUR PTO

There are many ways to support our PTO, including...

Membership: Become a member. See our Membership Form for eight great reasons to join this important group. Becoming a member does not obligate you to volunteer, but shows that you support the CLS PTO and our mission.

Fundraisers: The PTO runs several fundraisers throughout the school year. The exact fundraisers for 2022-2023 are still being assessed. Information and order forms may be sent home with students or e-mailed to parents. Some fundraisers conducted in the past have included:

- <u>Spirit Wear:</u> This fundraiser includes a selection of clothing items, car magnets, and water bottles that showcase our school logo. This is a great way to show your school spirit!
- <u>Munson's Chocolates/Butterbraids:</u> This is a delicious way to raise money for our school! The orders from this fundraiser will be delivered in time for Easter.
- <u>Plant Sale:</u> Our plant sale is held right before Mother's Day and offers a wide selection of hanging plants, potted plants, 6-packs of flowers, vegetables, herbs, and more. Each classroom has an opportunity to visit the plant sale to purchase items for someone special!
