Halloween Party: Our much-loved annual Halloween Party is held on a Friday night before Halloween. We typically have 150-175 children attend! We need a chairperson and a committee of 4-5 individuals to plan this event. To facilitate planning, a detailed checklist of tasks to complete has been developed by former chairpersons. We also need many volunteers the night of the party. We will be considering outside options for this event.			
Holiday Shoppe: The holiday shop is open for 2-3 days in December. All students attend the shop during school with their classes. This is a great way for kids to independently do some holiday shopping for their loved ones! We need a chairperson to coordinate the shop and volunteers to help run it. The vendor we use makes this event easy to run; all we need is someone to take the lead!			
Running Club: A chairperson and volunteers to run the Running Club are needed. Running Club takes place before school in the fall and spring, ideally twice per week. The chairperson would be responsible for setting up a volunteer schedule and ordering supplies as needed. Volunteers are needed to track students’ mileage and distribute necklaces and charms.			

Movie Night: In February, we fill the gymnasium with blankets and pillows for Movie Night. This is a great, family friendly way to break up those long winter nights! We need a chairperson and a committee of 2-3 individuals to plan this event. A planning checklist has been developed for this event. We also need volunteers at the event.
