



MCKINNEY-VENTO SUPPORT FOR ELLINGTON FAMILIES

The McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act is a federal law that ensures immediate enrollment and educational stability for homeless children and youth. In accordance with the Act “homeless children and youth mean individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence” and includes those:

- **living with a friend, relative, or somewhere else;**
- **who are staying in a motel or hotel;**
- **who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings; or**
- **living in an emergency or transitional shelter or domestic violence shelter.**
