## **Working Papers for Minors**

Congratulations on your new job! Now what?

Upon obtaining a job, employees between the ages of 16 and 18 must have working papers to work in Connecticut. Those papers can be obtained in the School Counseling office.

## <u>During the summer, please call ahead - 860-896-2352 - to schedule an appointment.</u>

Please bring with you a Promise of Employment letter from your employer that clearly states the following:

- 1. Street address of where the minor will be working
- 2. Hourly wage as a dollar amount at or above current minimum wage
- 3. Specific job description
- 4. Maximum number of hours that could be worked
- 5. Name, contact information and signature of an authorized official
